I. Jesus knows the _____, and counsels his followers to have _____.

He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again. Mark 8:31

He was teaching his disciples, . . . [and] said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into the hands of men. They will kill him, and after three days he will rise."

Mark 9:31

“The Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and teachers of the law. They will condemn him to death and will hand him over to the Gentiles,³⁴ who will mock him and spit on him, flog him and kill him. Three days later he will rise.” Mark 10:33,34

- The colt is the animal the messiah will ride. (Zech 9:9; Gen 49:11)
- An unbroken donkey or horse is sacred, appropriate for a king. (Num 19:2, Deut 21:3)
- Jesus commands his disciples to get the colt for him. (v2,3)
- Jesus calls himself “Lord,” a veiled reference to his identity. (v3, 2:28; 5:19; 12:36,37)
- Jesus commands, his commands are explicitly obeyed. (2-6)
